Overview of Occupational Hygiene

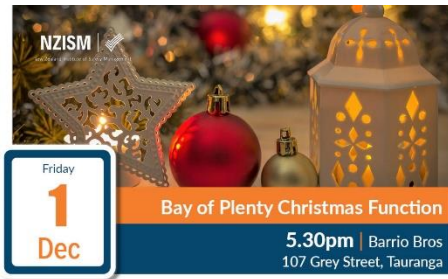
