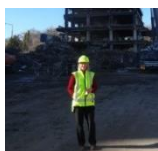

Lyn Osmer is an Assessment Inspector specialising in HSNO at WorkSafe NZ. Lynn will be talking on the new Class 6 and Class 8 HSNO requirements followed by Kelvin Sparks and then a general HSNO Q & A session.



Kelvin Sparks is an experienced health and safety professional with extensive knowledge

across a range of industries including construction, mining and government agencies. Given the changes to the hazardous substances legislation in 2017 he decided that a move towards becoming a Hazardous Substance Certifier was a natural progression in his career. Kelvin will be talking on the audit process for certification which requires in-depth inspections of the area, equipment and supporting documentation to ensure compliance with the regulations.
