#### Election of a new President

This year's national NZISM AGM will be held in Wellington on 9 September and Greg Dearsly will be stepping down as President. Nominees for candidates for this role are required to be called by national office not less than 12 weeks before the date of the AGM (deadline 17 June).

Each Branch is entitled to nominate only one candidate for the role of President. To be eligible, the nominee must have been an active volunteer member of the Institute for more than two years. An active volunteer member is a Member that has participated in an NZISM committee, or as Branch Manager or Branch Secretary.

Formal notification and explanation of the process will be advised to all members in the national newsletter over the next few weeks.
