

Site Visit 11 April University of Auckland Newmarket Campus

A site visit to the UoA Newmarket campus on Khyber Pass Rd has been organized for the NZISM on Wednesday 11 April. We are limited to a maximum of 30 people, therefore please RSVP to Rob Powell r.powell@auckland.ac.nz without delay if you wish to attend (please state your name, contact number, email, organization, and whether you need parking).

Newmarket is where the UoA conducts research into heavy engineering and the tour will include visits to the Wind Tunnel Hall, Technical Services (the main fabrication workshop with fixed machinery and metal working facilities), the Fluids Research Hall, and Structures Test Laboratory (Earthquake test lab). It is an ideal opportunity to see what is the practice behind a lot of engineering theory, and delegates will also be able to see how risk assessments are applied in a practical way and how the University works with private enterprise in a commercial capacity.

Given the limited amount of spaces available, we may need to be allocate a maximum of two people per organization.

Times: Arrive no later than 11.45am for sign in and safety brief. Depart around 1.30 pm.
