Safety Differently/Safety II

Moni is a Safety Differently Coach with a track record of success using modern adaptive methods since 2015. She has spent four years in New Zealand's innovation sector as the first Safety Lead for Rocket Lab since 2017 and prior to, Fletcher Construction's house-in-a-day project. She was a 2019 Finalist for an HRINZ Award for leading the implementation of Safety Differently at Rocket Lab.

Moni's raft of experience includes 23 years in operational and safety consulting roles with Fletcher Building plus other high-risk industries including construction, agriculture, manufacturing, engineering and transport. She was a facilitator for six years as an Impac Services Associate.

SAFETY DIFFERENTLY IN PRACTICE

THE POWER OF 'AND'
